P.E.

As Athletes, we will be focussing on Gymnastics. Children will learn to move and support their body parts and learn to stretch and extend their body parts.

Children will learn how to perform a series of balances, supports and rolls safely, and form their own gymnastic sequence from memory.

They will learn to use equipment and their own bodies to show control and coordination

Maths

As mathematicians we will concentrate on correct digit formation and writing number names. We will look at place value of numbers to 20 and we will use the addition and subtraction methods which we previously learnt and apply them to numbers up to 20. We will also be exploring shape.

English

As readers and writers we will be focusing on the text the 'Man On The Moon' by Simon Bartram. We will make predictions about the text and think about who the main character is and his role. We will be writing a short recount in the form of a postcard – creating a poster to attract visitors to the moon. We will also be exploring non-fiction texts and we will write our own information booklet about astronauts.

Music

As musicians we will listen to live and recorded music with a space theme. We will be creating and combining sounds using a variety of dimensions of music. We will also learn songs about space and the planets.

History

As historians we will be learning about the first Moon landing and other significant historical space events. We will be exploring the life of Mae Jamison and finding out how she became the first African American woman to travel into space.
